Sherman argues that the platonic soul is immortal and the Ideas eternal wholly and solely in human dialogical activity the rest is muthologia and that the world of our experience is a product of an ongoing act of interpretation or dianoetic dialegesthai. This reinterpretation of the platonic Ideas will be especially interesting to students and scholars of classics ancient philosophy and continental philosophy.
