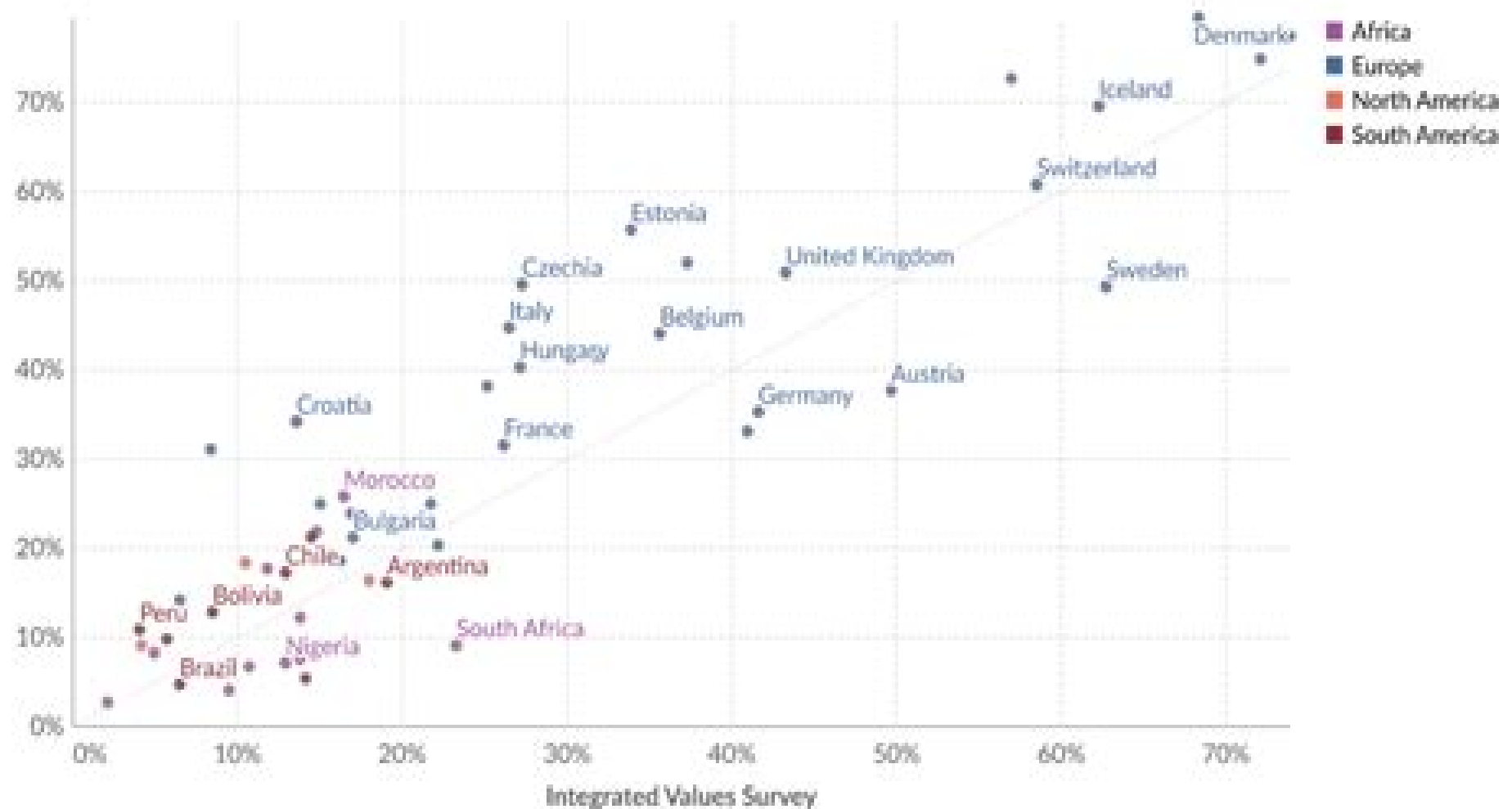


Interpersonal trust measured in different surveys
