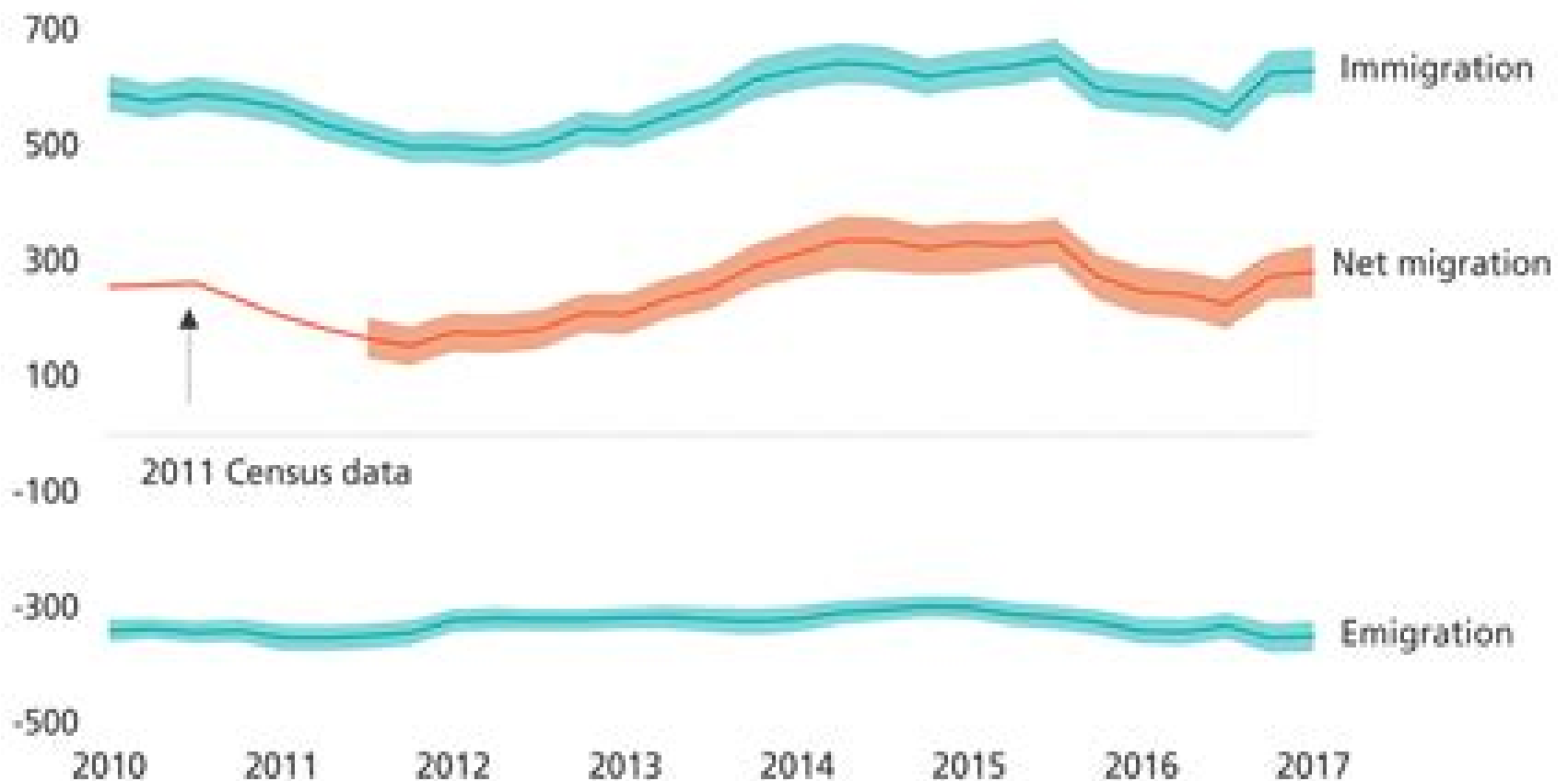


Long-term international migration estimates with confidence intervals (thousands)
