These chapters are anchored in various theoretical and disciplinary points of departure such as the history of collections and collecting, literary theory and criticism, the histories of science, art history, and visual culture, word and image studies, as well as print culture and book illustration. Authors draw upon a wide range of visual material hitherto insufficiently explored and placed in context in some cases hidden in museums and archives or previously assessed only from a disciplinary standpoint that favored either the image or the text but not both in relation to each other. They include manuscript illuminations representing compilers and collections, frontispieces and other accompanying plates published in catalogues and museographies, astronomical diagrams, mixed pictographic alphabetic accounting documents, Spanish baroque paintings, illustrative frontispieces or series inspired by or designed for single novels or anthologies, anatomical drawings featured in encyclopedic publications, visual patterns of volcanic formations, engravings representing the New World that accompany non-fictional travelogues, commonplace books that interlace text and images, and graphic satire. Geographically, the collection covers imperial centers: Great Britain, France, the Netherlands, and Spain, as well as their colonial periphery: New France, Mexico, Central America, South America, in particular Brazil, parts of Africa, and the island of Ceylon.
