Summary of Chapter Five (Continued)

- Proper calculation of **discounted present value** is necessary when a project's cost and/or benefit are dispersed over time.
 - Ranking projects using Sensitivity Analysis and NPV are preferred methods because of their transparency and logical consistency.
- The focus on "safety" in the FSMA means that **risk management** is an integral consideration.
 - Risks are measured with probabilistic scenarios. When probabilities of events are included, then risk aversion theory is relevant when making recommendations in CBA Analysis.
- FSMA implementation involves the FDA's new power to regulate the safety of imported foods. **Imports and exports** are another key economic influence on the US agri-food system. We turn our attention to international trade and its relationship to agri-food policy in the next chapter.
