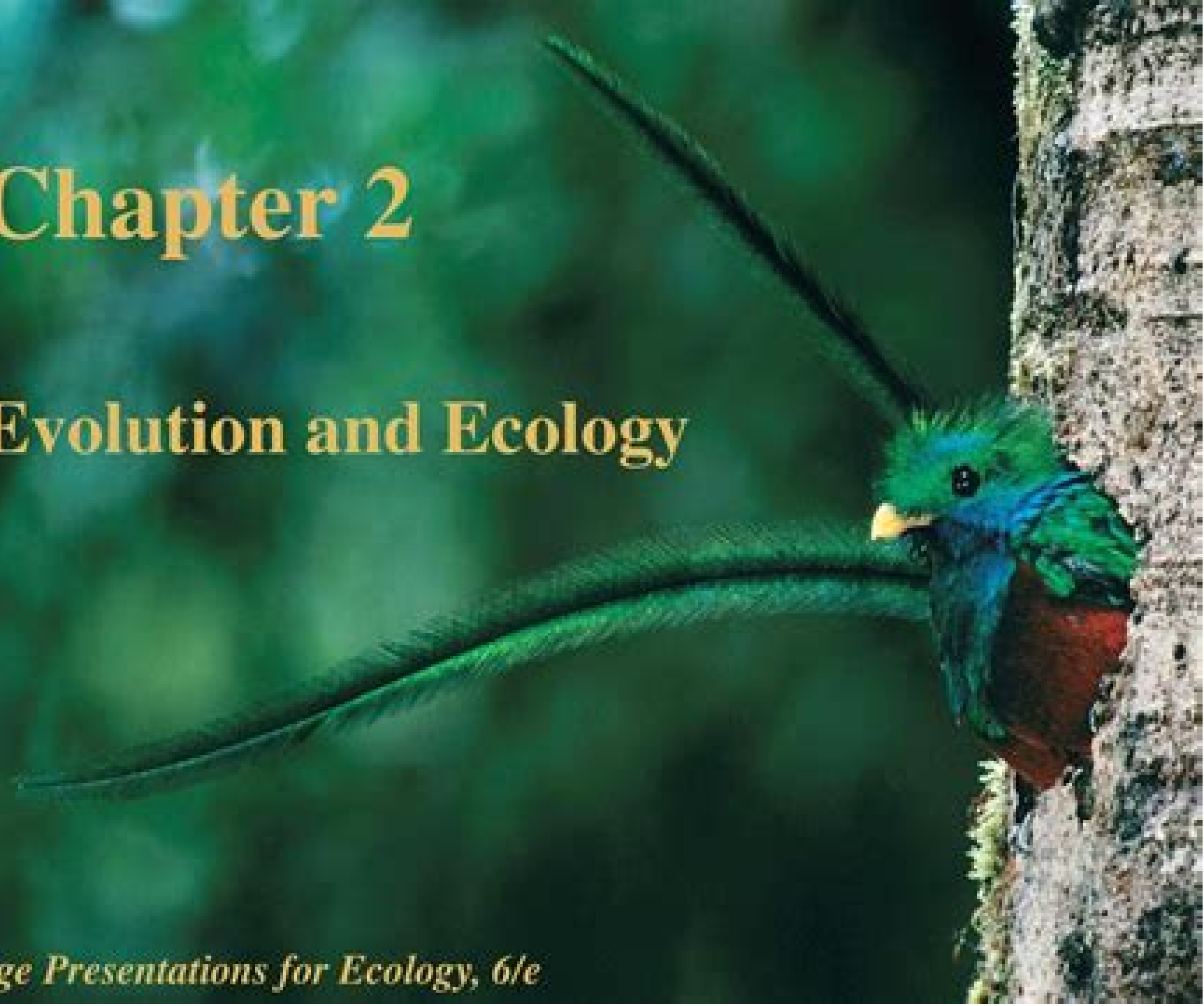

Consequently psychiatric understanding and research has to distinguish sharply between those mental brain structures and functions which constitute the innate predisposition to a certain mental disorder versus those ones involved secondarily during the lifespan This consideration is detailed in the case of schizophrenia spectrum of disorders The above theoretical considerations have important therapeutic preventive and research implications
