Anselin, 2013-03-09 Spatial econometrics deals with spatial dependence and spatial heterogeneity critical aspects of the data used by regional scientists These characteristics may cause standard econometric techniques to become inappropriate In this book I combine several recent research results to construct a comprehensive approach to the incorporation of spatial effects in econometrics My primary focus is to demonstrate how these spatial effects can be considered as special cases of general frameworks in standard econometrics and to outline how they necessitate a separate set of methods and techniques encompassed within the field of spatial econometrics My viewpoint differs from that taken in the discussion of spatial autocorrelation in spatial statistics e g most recently by Cliff and Ord 1981 and Upton and Fingleton 1985 in that I am mostly concerned with the relevance of spatial effects on model specification estimation and other inference in what I call a model driven approach as opposed to a data driven approach in spatial statistics I attempt to combine a rigorous econometric perspective with a comprehensive treatment of methodological issues in spatial analysis **History of Spatial Economic Theory** C.
