

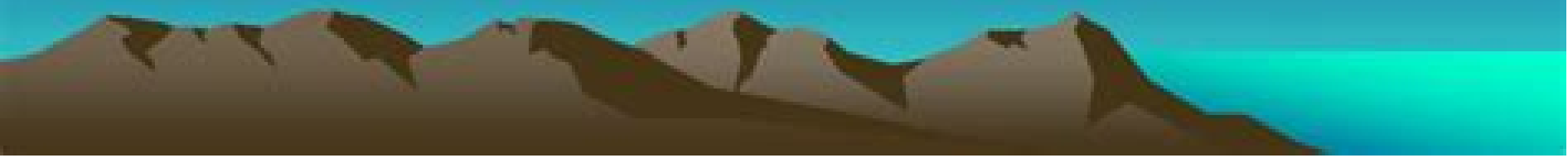
# What is Environmental Science?
