

Locality Maria Rita Manzini, 1992 In this ambitious monograph Manzini organizes and clarifies the voluminous evidence that exists on local dependencies according to a single unified theory of Locality Locality is a simpler and more comprehensive alternative to the barriers approach the antecedent based approach and the connectedness approach subsuming all the major locality principles Subjacency ECP and binding theory invoked in the other approaches and explaining a set of islands that remain refractory to those approaches The first chapter defines the empirical problem and provides an overview of the solution it also introduces the three main alternatives to Locality theory The second chapter presents Manzini s theory in detail and includes a unification of Subjacency and the antecedent government clause of the ECP and a unification of the ECP internal disjunction between the antecedent government and the head government clause In chapter 3 Manzini argues for the empirical superiority of Locality offering data predicting that Complex NP islands Tense islands and Definiteness islands all belong to the same fundamental type while multiple WH islands reflect the fact that at most two overlapping extraction paths are available at any given point in a derivation. The bewildering variation in word order among the languages of the world says Cinque should not dissuade us from researching what if anything determines which orders are possible and attested attestable and which orders are impossible and not attested nonattestable both when they maximally conform to the head final or head initial types and when they depart from them to varying degrees His aim is to develop a restrictive theory of word order variation not just a way to derive the ideal head initial and head final word orders but also the mixed cases In the absence of an explicit theory of linearization Cinque provides a general approach to derive linear order from a hierarchical arrangement of constituents specifically by assuming a restrictive movement analysis that creates structures that can then be linearized by Richard S Kayne's Linear Correspondence Axiom

Composing Questions Hadas Kotek, 2019-02-19 An investigation of the syntax and semantics of wh questions through the lens of intervention effects offering a new proposal on overt and covert wh movement In this book Hadas Kotek investigates the syntax and semantics of wh questions offering a new solution to a central question in the study of interrogatives given that overt wh movement is cross linguistically common is syntactic movement a prerequisite for the interpretation of wh phrases Some linguists argue that all wh phrases undergo movement to interrogative C even if covertly others propose mechanisms of in situ interpretation that do not require any movement Kotek moves beyond these positions to argue that wh in situ does move covertly but not necessarily to C Instead she contends wh in situ undergoes a short movement step akin to
