Tingley, 2017 This study sought a better understanding of lobbying tactics used in higher education at the state level Given the economic recession the United States experienced in recent years it is now more important than ever for public higher education to maintain its current funding levels and effectively communicate needed policy changes To advance all public institutions there must be communication with legislative officials and state level higher education governing board members. The primary research question for this
