## Be Reflective

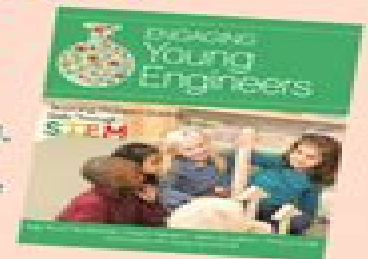


- Pause and think about your teaching practices
