During the Warring States Period, there was a chivalrous man-ealled Louh Juhng Lihn who was very fond of being a mediator. The state of Cheuhn sent its army to attack the state of Jiuh. Jiuh then asked for the help of other feudal kings. But they were all so afraid of Cheuhn that they dared not intervene. The king of the state of Ngaih even sent an envoy to advise Jiuh that it would be better to recognize Cheuhn as emperor. When Louh Juhng Lihn heard that, he went to see the envoy. He succeeded in persuading him that Cheuhn was unreliable. Later, the king of Cheuhn realized that the feudal kings had united, so he gave up the invasion against Jiuh and withdrew his troops.

Wöhsihlöuh may refer to Löuh Juhng Lihn. Some people say it may refer to Såam Löuh, the title of an official in ancient China. The government appointed some old men of good moral standing and reputation in a village to be the Såam Löuh. Actually they were peacemakers, responsible for all the affairs of the village and for mediating and judging the arguments of the villagers. Now we do not have such officials. But it is still a custom that the head of a clan or the seniors of a village will be requested to act as mediator.
