The cultural geography of the Indian village is carefully laid out to assign to Dalit dwellings the lowliest and least desirable areas—the southern outskirts believed to be the abode of Yama, the God of death; the tail end of the irrigation systems; close to the most polluting areas; or on the fringes of deserts (P. Sainath in Devi 2000: 50).

Setting the Scene

Above the main entrance to the Melavassal Housing Unit, in Madurai, stood a makeshift archway atop two poles painted in light blue, red and white stripes. The board forming the arch displayed the striking images of a roaring leopard and the face of a man cross-cut by bolts of lightning. In between the two images bold lettering pronounced this to be a stronghold of the DPI. The face staring insolently out at Hotel Tamil Nadu, across the road, was that of Thirumavalavan, the leader of the movement. On either side of the gateway the compound wall had been turned into a series of political meeting points. The slogans and images of the DMK, the AIADMK, the Communists, and the Liberation Panthers vied with Hindu shrines for wall space. Several parties had constructed ramshackle shelters in front of murals depicting their leaders and symbols. These 'halls' (*marrom*), as they were grandiosely referred to, served little material function and adherents of the organisations in question tended to congregate elsewhere. The booths only came into their own during moments of political import such as elections, when canvassers gathered with their supporters. They mostly stood deserted save for stray chickens or pigs rooting around for rubbish. The bright colours and vivid portraits of leaders and symbols competed for attention with the hoardings featuring movie posters or advertisements.
