

of two other seminal modernist works T S Eliot s Wasteland and James Joyce s Ulysses Thirdly Jacob s Room is commonly regarded as Virginia Woolf's first experimental novel in which she in her own phrase Virginia Woolf: Writing the World Pamela L. The central aesthetic question which is debated in this room or forum relates to the essential art of modern fiction in general and the efficiency of characterisation in fiction in particular It is argued that Virginia Woolf probes into the epistemic question of the essence of modern man and in an attempt to capture the essence of her protagonist speculates on the corresponding literary question how and to what extent the soul of man can to be represented in fiction.
