Energy-Dispersive X-Ray Spectrometry

6.1. ENERGY-DISPERSIVE X-RAY SPECTROMETRY

6.1.1. Introduction

The distinction drawn in this book between energy-dispersive and nondispersive methods is given in the last paragraph of Section 3.2. Excitation for energy dispersion by high- and low-power x-ray tubes, radio-isotopes, and ion beams is discussed in Sections 4.1.4, 4.1.3, and 4.1.2, respectively. The advantages and limitations of energy and wavelength dispersion are compared in Section 3.5.4. This section (6.1) is concerned with only the analytical techniques of energy dispersion.

Energy-dispersive x-ray spectrochemical analysis can be applied on standard commercial x-ray fluorescence spectrometers and diffractometers using proportional and scintillation counters. However, because of the poor resolution of these detectors, such application is feasible only for specimens having only one heavier element in a light matrix—or at most three or four such elements having widely separated pulse-height distributions.

For fluorescence spectrometers, the goniometer is fixed at $0^{\circ} 2\theta$ and the crystal is removed; coarse collimators may be used in the source and detector positions. The specimen is placed in the same position as for wavelength dispersion. In earlier instruments having tabletop goniometers, like that shown in Figure 3.2, the distance from specimen to detector may be reduced by mounting the detector after the source collimator. For diffractometers, the goniometer is fixed at $90^{\circ} 2\theta$, and coarse collimators or wide slits may be used. The specimen is placed in the same position as for diffractometry so that lines joining the specimen with the x-ray tube and
