psychology

- officially defined as "the scientific investigation of mental processes (thinking, remembering, feeling) and behaviour"
- it began within philosophy, with a focus on logic and reasoning
 - it evolved to become a scientific discipline
- the word psychology comes from two ancient Greek words
 - psyche (meaning mind or soul)
 - logos (meaning the study of)

 - they are interested in knowing people why people do certain things
