SYMPTOMS

Coughing, wheezing, shortness of breath, and chest tightness usually occur during or after physical activity.

TRIGGERS

Physical activity
Cold or dry air and poor air quality

TIPS AND HOW TO COPE

Wear a loosely fitting scarf over your nose
Don't forget warm up exercises
Check air quality before outdoor exercises
Drink lots of water
Listen to your body, stop and rest when you have symptoms
