categorized Argentina's indigenous peoples into three groups: basic hunters and food gatherers without pottery, advanced gatherers and hunters, and basic farmers who developed pottery. The Pampas and Patagonia were dominated by the first group, while the second included tribes like the Charrá, Minuane, and Guaraní. The third group, inhabiting regions such as the Quebrada de Humahuaca, adopted farming practices and pottery.
