# 3500 BCE

The earliest glass artefacts that have been discovered are made in Egypt and Mesopotamia.

#### **650 BCE**

The first manual is written explaining different glass-making methods. This writing is later discovered in the library of the last Assyrian king, Ashurbanipal.

# 1 CE

Glassblowing is invented in Babylon. This technique thrives across ancient Rome, allowing the creation of a huge range of glass shapes quickly and cheaply.



## 100 CE

After glass' rapid growth in popularity, it now holds much less worth, becoming available beyond the wealthy.

## 1000

With higher demands for glass spreading worldwide, some cities, such as Alexandria in Egypt, become glassmanufacturing centres.

## 1590

Glass for telescopes and microscopes is developed in the Netherlands.



Clear and colourless glass, named 'cristallo' glass, is invented by Angelo Barovier.

#### 1226

Broad sheet glass begins production in Sussex, Long balloons of glass are blown and then flattened, producing the first window glass in Britain.

#### 1765

After Caspar Lehmann's method for cutting rock crystal into glass in 1600, crystal glass production begins en masse.

#### 1827

The glass-pressing machine is invented, providing a step forward in mass-produced glassware.

#### 1903

An automatic glassblowing machine is invented by Michael Owens.

#### 1959

Float glass is invented, enabling more control over product thickness.
