Deconstructionism Hector Davidson, Deconstructionism emerged in the late 20th century as a philosophical and literary movement that fundamentally questioned the nature of meaning language and interpretation It is primarily associated with the work of French philosopher Jacques Derrida who in the 1960s and 1970s began to develop ideas that would challenge long held assumptions in philosophy literary theory and critical thought The movement was a response to structuralism which sought to uncover the underlying structures that govern language and society In contrast deconstruction aimed to show that meaning is inherently unstable and that texts and concepts can never be fully fixed or understood in a singular unchanging way The foundational work of Jacques Derrida is central to deconstructionism His concept of diff rance a term he coined in 1968 highlighted the ways in which meaning is always deferred and never fully attainable Derrida s analysis of language showed that words and concepts derive meaning not from a stable inherent essence but from their relationships with other words In this sense meaning is always in flux and any attempt to pin it down is doomed to fail
