Fathers and Early Childhood Programs Jay Fagan, Glen Palm, 2004 Changes in family life and the proliferation of early childhood program have placed more attention on the early childhood years and what the parent school relationship should be like during this period of a child's life The emphasis of Fathers and Early Childhood Programs is on the positive impacts that fathers can have upon their young children when father involvement is supported. The reader is introduced to many of the critical issues being studied about fathers in the social sciences. The first section of the book addresses the history theory and research relevant to fathers involvement in such programs The second section of the book focuses on practice with fathers in early childhood setting complete with case studies and examples of father involvement activities Father Involvement Andrew Burwick, Jeanne Bellotti, Charles Nagatoshi, 2004 Father involvement enhances children's well being A growing body of research supports this conclusion showing that children with involved fathers exhibit greater school readiness increased cognitive development higher levels of empathy and other positive characteristics Administration for Children and Families 2004a Research also indicates that many low income fathers are present and involved in the lives of their young children Vogel et al 2003 As the importance of fathers involvement in raising children has become clear policymakers interest in effective strategies for engaging fathers in early childhood programs also has grown In February 2001 the Administration on Children Youth and Families ACYF partnered with the Office of Child Support Enforcement OCSE to fund 21 Early Head Start fatherhood demonstration projects Selected through a competitive process the demonstration grantees were funded for three years to develop and implement creative practices that would lead to increased involvement of fathers in Early Head Start and in the lives of their children ACYF also commissioned an evaluation by Mathematica Policy Research Inc MPR to track the progress of grantees focusing on the strategies they adopted and the challenges they faced The first phase of the evaluation resulted in two reports highlighting the demonstration programs planning and implementation process and documenting lessons regarding staffing structures making programs father friendly recruiting fathers and designing services for them and creating partnerships with child support agencies In this report the authors present findings from the third year of the demonstration focusing on the evolution of program practices perceived results of the demonstration and sustainability of father involvement projects Appended are 1 Staff Survey Director Version and 2 Father Father Figure Information Form Individual sections contain footnotes Contains 10 tables and 4 figures Father Involvement in an Early Childhood Education Program Utilizing a Continuity of Care Approach, 2016 This study aimed to examine fathers involvement in a continuity of care setting as well as center staff strategies for promoting fathers involvement in early childhood education Participants in this study included 15 fathers and 5 staff in a university based preschool in Southern California The San Diego State University Children's Center In order to gain a better understanding of how fathers are involved in their young children's education participants were asked to report their beliefs and practices

regarding father involvement through a brief survey Results indicated that 100% of participants both fathers and staff believe that it is important for fathers to be involved in their child s early education Participants identified four specific benefits children are more likely to seek out both fathers and mothers for help when fathers are more involved fathers play an important role in exposing children to different perspective father involvement leads to stronger attachment bonds between fathers and their children and fathers appreciate being able to be a role model for their children Participants also identified three barriers that prevent fathers from being involved in early education a restrictive work schedule traditional societal expectations about the roles of mothers and fathers in children's early education and the impact of divorce on fathers ability to engage as often as they would like Finally participants shared multiple strategies to help early educators promote further father involvement in early education The Role of the Father in Child Development Michael E. Exploring and Evaluating Fathers' Needs and Interests Within a Preschool Program Laura Drew, 2022 This thesis project explored parent education topics and involvement opportunities of interest to a group of fathers of young children Eighteen fathers from of a private college based preschool program serving campus and community families with children from age 2 to age 5 participated The goal was to uncover and develop resources for fathers with young children and examine effective strategies for the program to involve fathers Using two exploratory pilot meetings fathers identified several topics of interest and discussed their preferences for involvement in the preschool program For example the topic of greatest interest was how to support children s development of emotional regulation The fathers also expressed interest in involvement opportunities such as ongoing meetings with other fathers parenting meetings for all parents and volunteering in their child's classroom Fathers indicated that they were eager to viii be involved but need more information and support regarding their options. The fathers ideas suggested a multi pronged plan for supporting and engaging fathers Father involvement initiatives include a parenting workshop on supporting children's development of emotional regulation a fatherhood group that meets several times

throughout the year a comprehensive survey of all fathers in the program which alerts them to the full range of involvement opportunities and a series of staff training sessions to build the staff s knowledge and skills in father engagement involvement. The thesis project suggests father involvement approaches which can be implemented over the school year Implications for early childhood programs and potential directions for future research are also discussed Examination of Early Childhood Educators' Use of Program Policies Designed to Encourage Father Involvement Caroline Sophie Omolo, 2008 This study investigated early childhood educators use of program policies that are designed to encourage father involvement in two early childhood programs The study centered on comparing how well lead teachers from two early childhood programs Head Start and developmental preschool programs used program policies designed to encourage father involvement A total of 120 lead teachers 65 from Head Start programs and 55 from developmental preschool programs participated in the study Two measures were used in this study The program s involvement with fathers was evaluated using the Program Assessment Rating scale PAR a measure of early childhood educators perceived use of program policies aimed at involving fathers in their programs The degree of father involvement in the early childhood programs was evaluated using Levine's Assessment of Father Involvement Rating scale LAFIR a measure of early childhood educators perception of the levels of father involvement in their programs Frequencies means standard deviations and independent samples t tests for the subscale PAR measure scores were calculated for Head Start and developmental lead teachers Results indicated that for both educator samples the participants stated that their programs reflected an adequate of high level of commitment to fathers on all but one subscale the program evaluation subscale The results of the independent samples t tests reflected that the mean scores of Head Start lead teachers were significantly different from their developmental preschool counterparts on three subscales of the PAR the outreach and recruitment subscale parent family education practice subscale and program evaluation subscale No significant differences between the two groups were found on the other four subscales program characteristics subscale staff attitudes and background subscale parent child interaction subscale and co parenting and family development subscale Bivariate analyses revealed that for Head Start lead teachers positive and significant relationships exist between father involvement and all seven subscales On the other hand the results reflect that for developmental preschool lead teachers positive and significant relationships are also present between father involvement and all except one subscale the outreach and recruitment subscale Multiple regression analyses however revealed that for the Head Start lead teachers no partial correlation between any of the seven subscales and the father Promising Practices for Partnering with Families in the Early Years Mary M. involvement index was significant at p Cornish, 2008-08-01 This volume is directed toward research to practice issues related to partnering with families of children birth through age 5 This monograph and the next monograph focuses on family and school involvement issues in two age categories This sixth volume analyzes family involvement practices across a variety of settings and programs at the early
