as mentioned in Introduction of the study to trace scope on full length study in context to Faulkner's women characters. At times the survey led to conclude that Faulkner himself is not projecting as pleasant pictures of women in his novels as he does in the case of male figures. In fact, Faulkner was accused of being hostile to women. At times Faulkner may strike us as a misogynist. These points led to give a kind of impulse to start working on the women characters in Faulkner. His imaginary fictional world Yoknapatawpha explains the intertextuality so sometimes the same women character in different types of roles in his novels or shows amelioration and redemption in his other text. Keeping all these points in consideration as his indispensable women characters fascinate to study in depth and I could get the form under the heading Faulkner's Treatment of Women. It is a humble attempt. I do not claim it to be the last word on the issue.
