The id operates on the pleasure principle, the ego mediates between the id and reality by acting on the reality principle, and the superego represents our brain's morality.

- **Id:** The id operates on instinctual drives and the pleasure principle.
- **Ego:** The ego mediates between desires and reality, seeking practicality.
- **Superego:** The superego enforces moral standards and acts as the conscience.
