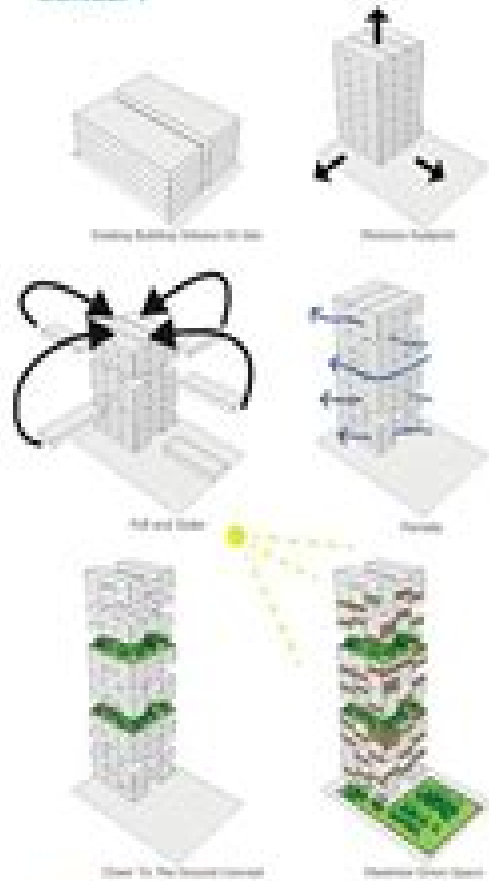

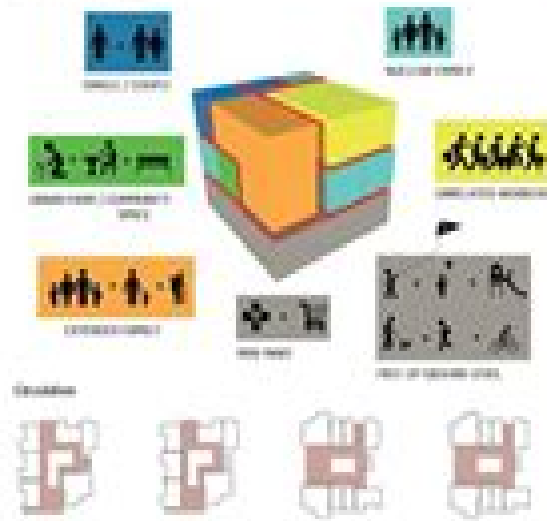

FLOOR PLAN OF EACH UNIT



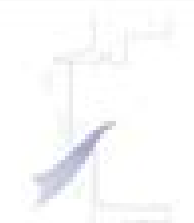
