Lewis: a Living Library Margaret Anne Rogers, Fairleigh Dickinson University, 1970 C S Lewis doubtless was a connoisseur of many books whose first pages appealed to his taste for his personal library of nearly 3 000 books is now housed at Wroxton College in the town of Wroxton in Oxfordshire England As thesis researcher I undertook the project of a descriptive exposition of the library of C S Lewis through personal interest in the graduate program of the college and a rather thorough acquaintance with C S Lewis writings I hope that the developed thesis will provide both the casual visitor and the interested scholar with sufficient detailed information for exploring further the many interesting volumes to be found The present acquisition list at Wroxton consists of 2 710 books These are listed in the Index provided with this thesis There are several possible ways of analyzing the Lewis collection and I chose units some of which overlap of 1 examples of scholarship 2 old and unusual books owned by Lewis 3 foreign books 4 religious comments in books and 5 personal inscriptions both to Lewis by others and his own inscriptions in books The visitor to the Wroxton Library will enjoy many of the books in the C S Lewis collection for the variety they represent and the interests and selectivity to be observed in the books Lewis owned One may enjoy the writings of Hakluyt Sir Francis Bacon Shakespeare the Romantic Poets essayists novelists religious and philosophical writers through the eyes of Dr Lewis as he underlined and wrote both pithy and explanatory commentary on much of what he read The Index to the C S Lewis Library hopefully will serve as a guide to the specialized literary collection
