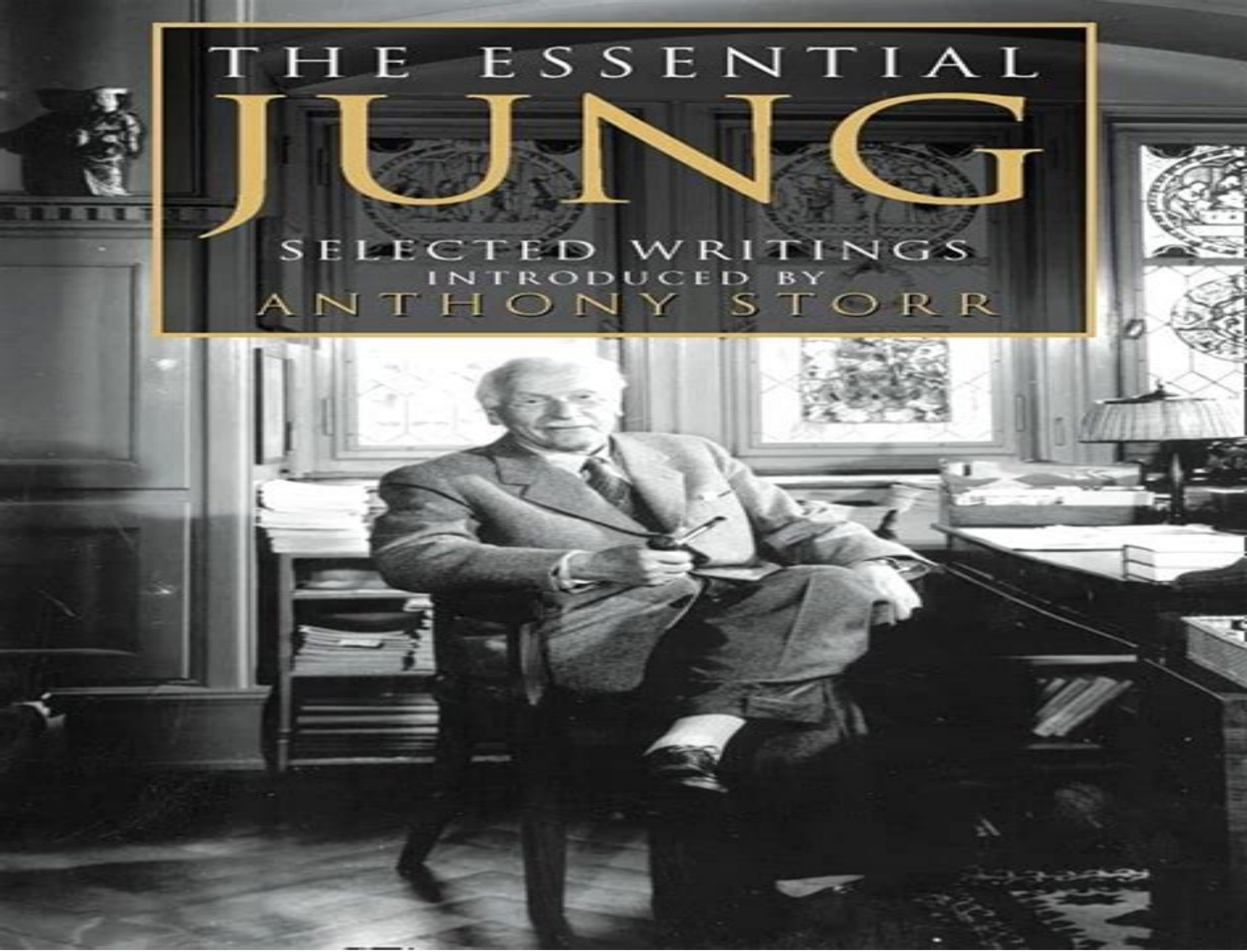

uncomfortably and uncannily around the boundaries between good and evil life and death victim and villain past and present civilization and primitive barbarity organic and machine or artificial technology In most of Banks s work conventions of the Gothic boil or simmer whether it be the barbarities of the past entering the present the ambivalent literary device of the Doppelganger or the blurred boundaries between the life of the dreaming unconscious and real life Banks incorporates the fantastic the mythological and the psychological to re sculpt the Gothic s early fictional motifs and ethical concerns for our own time and then he projects them star wards enabling him to elaborate a futuristic myth of socio political salvation through technological expertise With reference to many other writers including J G Ballard Stephen King Doris Lessing Mary Shelley and Banks s fellow Scot Alasdair Gray this book rather in the style of the Gothic itself straddles the boundary dividing the scholastic from popular writing The style is clear and accessible and should appeal to both the academic and the general intelligent reader of Banks s work
