Comets, referred to as icy giants, have fascinated astronomers for centuries. These celestial bodies, often described by their glowing tails, are unpredictable appearances, are remnants from the early stages of our solar system. Comets carry valuable information about the primordial conditions and processes that shaped our solar system, making them intriguing subjects of scientific study and observation.



"Origins and Composition"

Comets can be found in various regions of the solar system. The Oort Cloud and the Kuiper Belt are two primary sources. Comets originate from icy bodies, primarily short-period comets, which have a short-Oort Cloud (known as long-period comets). They consist of a nucleus, composed of ice, dust, and volatile compounds, surrounded by a glowing atmosphere or coma that often appears as a tail.

"Orbital Dynamics and Disruptive Factors"

Comets follow elongated orbits, often coming within close proximity to the inner solar system, while others are seen in passing orbits. As comets approach the Sun, solar radiation sublimates the volatile materials in the nucleus, creating a glowing coma and an expanding cloud of gas and dust—and a tail that always points away from the Sun (in the solar wind).

"Coma and Tail Formation"

As comets approach the Sun, the volatile materials in the nucleus sublimates.
