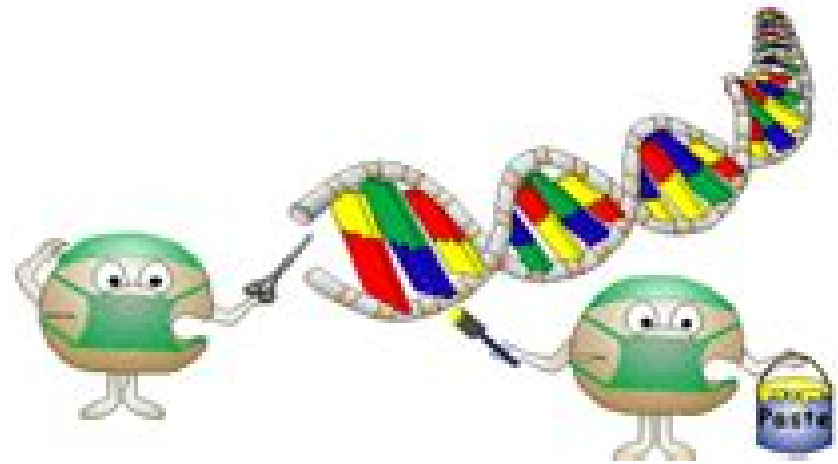


Genetic Engineering
