Pre-industrial England was, in fact, a hazardous place to inhabit and became increasingly so from the sixteenth century onwards. Food supplies became scarcer and the population increased and thus 'the poor became less well fed and more vulnerable to illness'. Fear of famine led to a decline in hospitality and, therefore, the impoverishment of those who depended on it. However, hunger was seasonal and amount of illness was related to geographical locality. For example, the Fen districts were notorious for

Some diseases like the plague and syphilis were epidemic in nature, others like dysentery, malaria and smallpox were virtually endemic in pre-industrial England. Clarkson writes: 'Far from being a creation of nineteenth century urban society, alimentary ailments were as common as fresh air in pre-industrial England and as much a part of the country scene as ploughing and harvest.' This 'army of death' was ineffectively staved off by bleeding, purging and astrology. The absence of any dis-

tinction between nervous and bodily distempers was

mirrored in the practice of medicine itself which was

closely interwoven with religious and magical ideas.

A White Paper should surely serve to give a clear lead to future activities as well as to identify the obstacles ahead.
