

6 STEPS TO

01. WRITE A BOOK OR PROPOSAL

Your entire book (fiction) or book proposal (nonfiction) is now so good that there's almost nothing you could do to improve it.

02. QUERY LITERARY AGENTS

If you want a traditional publishing deal that gets your print books into bookstores and attracts serious reviews, 99.99 times out of a 100, you'll need an agent.

03. YOUR AGENT SUBMITS TO PUBLISHING HOUSES

Just like you submitted your query to agents, your agent will craft a pitch and send it to a carefully-chosen list of acquiring editors at publishing houses.

04. SIGN THE BOOK DEAL

When an editor wants to buy your book (yay!), they will call your agent, who will later present their offer to you.

05. START EDITING AND PRE-PRODUCTION

Work with your editor to edit (or finish if it's nonfiction sold on proposal), and collaborate on cover, publicity, and marketing.

06. START SIGNING BOOKS!

Jump up and down when printed books arrive, and take your vitamins since publicity goes into full force.
