Thus it is expected that more joint ventures between foreign and large state owned firms will emerge in the post WTO entry economy But whether such firms will evolve into foreign controlled state owned firms is an interesting question which remains to be answered

Data analysis suggests that economic prosperity is positively associated with the occurrence of semi competitive elections only to a certain point above which the association turns negative. In other words both the least and the most developed villages are less likely to hold semi competitive elections for the chair of the village committee which is officially defined as an organization of self governance of villagers.
