Human development involves two main concepts which are

- ✓ Growth
- ✓ Maturation

GROWTH

This refers to an increase in body size, weight, shape and height. It involves quantitative changes. Growth is believed to occur rapidly during the pre-natal and adolescence periods of human development.

MATURATION

This refers to change in mental abilities and function ability e.g. language use, thinking etc. Maturation involves to a large extent the unfolding of genetic code and that is significantly a qualitative of human development.
