Reconstruction, Restoration, Renewal: Overcoming Misery and Trauma in Eva Figes's Konek Landing

Oftentimes read and catalogued simply as a prototypical example of the "Holocaust novel," Eva Figes's Konek Landing (1969) is a most interesting chimera of a book, merging different literary traditions and paratextual allusions with a view towards a better conceptualisation of the horrors of war. But at its very core, Figes's forgotten masterpiece offers so much more - it is a narrative based on myth and self-discovery, a response to the darkest time in the history of mankind and a moving auto-analysis of a hurting self. The novel traces the story of Stefan Konek, a German-Jewish man incarcerated in a Nazi prison. Quite like in a traditional Bildungsromon, it tersely acquaints the reader with Konek's childhood and his subsequent maturation in a number of analepses and prolepses, albeit drawing a veil over his distressing internment. Interpreted as the book's "blind spot" (Maurice Blanchot), this dramatic episode is a source of meaning and a potent impetus for the protagonist to reinvent himself anew as much as it is the main reason behind many aporias underlying the novel's tripartite structure. The portrayal of the after-war years fuses multiple different narratives, including the realist depictions of Konek's sea voyages and his immediate environs, the mythical evocations of the origins of human life, as well as a palimpsestuous layer of intertextual allusions that not only enhance the story but complicate its linearity. Based on memory, trauma, and affective studies scholarship, the present paper offers a new hermeneutic reappraisal of Konek Landing, whose specificity and many idiosyncrasies are accounted for and examined by a range of latest theoretical propositions. By invoking intense "emphatic unsettlement" (Dominick LaCapra), the novel as is posited – is deeply rooted in affective and traumatic realism (Michael Rothberg). and in its focus on characterial disintegration and problematic auto-creation - reminds the reader of the curative nature of testimonial accounts (Dori Laub).

Krystian Piotrowski reads English Literature at the Doctoral School in the Humanities of the Jagiellonian University in Kraków. His main academic pursuits include contemporary experimental prose, affect theory, somatic studies, life-writing, and the poetics and politics of the avant-garde. Piotrowski's doctoral dissertation focuses on the conceptualisation of the "Affective Vanguard" in twentieth-century British avant-garde literature.
