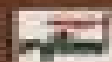

Uczestnikami konferencji byli studenci i pracownicy naukowcy Uniwersytetu Jagiellońskiego, Uniwersytetu im. Adama Mickiewicza w Poznaniu, katolickiego Uniwersytetu Lubelskiego, Uniwersytetu Warszawskiego i Uniwersytetu Wrocławskiego. Artykuły zawarte w tej publikacji stanowią przegląd najważniejszych zagadnień związanych z regulacjami prawnymi zawartymi w Konstytucji oraz z dziesięcioletnim stosowaniem aktualnie obowiązujących norm konstytucyjnych w praktyce. The core of the Constitution is similar to other liberal democratic constitutions but in addition it regulates a number of issues such as public finances and sources of law that are new to Polish constitutionalism and to constitutionalism in general. It considers in a detailed manner certain institutional choices made in the Constitution such as the bicameral parliament, the peculiar structure of the executive branch as well as the principle of independence of courts and judges, fundamental rights and local government. The book is a vital resource for all those interested in Poland's Constitution and the rich comparative constitutional insights the country offers. In addition to explaining the 1997 Constitution in its political, historical and social context, the book tackles the radical changes in particular within the judicial branch introduced by the new governing majority since 2015. These new regulations, constitutional in character but without formally changing the Constitution, challenged the rule of law, a key component of membership in the European Union. Polish Constitutional Documents 1790-1848 Anna Tarnowska, 2008-11-03 This volume of the edition presents exceptional documents from the early period of European constitutionalism with the constitution of May 3rd 1791 from the closing phase of the Polish Aristocratic Republic and the Grodno constitution of 1793. It incorporates the constitutional texts of the Napoleonic epoch such as those concerning the duchy of Warsaw of 1807 and of the period in which Poland ceased to exist as a sovereign state: the so-called Constitution of 1815, the 1825 amendment and the organic statute of 1832. Among the most interesting and hitherto almost unknown constitutional projects of Galicia which belonged to the Habsburg Monarchy following the partition of Poland in 1772 are the Magna Charta Leopoldina 1790 and two versions of the Lemberg Petition 1848. Documents pertaining to constitutions of the Free City of Kraków also known as the Republic of Kraków including constitutions from 1815, 1818 and 1833 with amendments have also been edited. In keeping with the publication series editing principles this volume contains a total of 21 documents in all the original languages in which they were

published at the time including Polish French German Latin Russian and old Ukrainian The texts have been edited and annotated by the law historian Anna Tarnowska Nicolaus Copernicus University Torun
