Heinrich Scheidemann's Keyboard Music Pieter Dirksen, 2017-07-05 One of the most remarkable tales of recent resurrections in the field of early keyboard music concerns the music of Heinrich Scheidemann c 1595 1663 Long considered a minor master overshadowed by such figures as his teacher Jan Pieterszoon Sweelinck or his fellow student Samuel Scheidt a number of major source discoveries made in the second half of the twentieth century the most important one being the discovery of the Zellerfeld tablatures have gradually raised his stature towards what it should now be namely that of the paramount figure in

Authorship is a pertinent issue for historical musicology and musicians more widely and some controversies concerned with major figures have even reached wider consciousness. Scholars have clarified some of the issues at stake in recent decades such as the places of borrowing and arranging in the creative process and the wider cultural significance of these practices. The discovery of new sources and methodologies has also opened up opportunities for reassessing specific authorship problems. Drawing upon this wider musicological literature as well as insights from other disciplines such as intellectual history and book history, this book aims to build on what has already been achieved by focussing on keyboard music. English keyboard music reached an unsurpassed level of sophistication in the late sixteenth and early seventeenth centuries as organists such as William Byrd and his students took a genre associated with domestic amateur performance and treated it as seriously as vocal music. There are two chapters on instruments: John Koster on the use of harpsichord during the period and Dominic Gwynn on the construction of Tudor style organs based on the surviving evidence we have for them. The next two contributions focus on two of the most important individual manuscript sources: Tihomir Popović challenges assumptions about *My Ladye Nevells Booke* by reflecting on what the manuscript can tell us about aristocratic culture and David J. Smith provides a detailed study of the famous Fitzwilliam Virginal Book. The discussion then broadens out into Pieter Dirksen's consideration of a wider selection of sources relating to John Bull which in turn connects closely to David Leadbetter's work on Gibbons' lute sources and questions of style.
