total U S population in the last decennial census recent estimates showed the Hispanic population to be 41.3 million as of July 1, 2004 or 14% of the nation's total population. However, this estimate does not include the 3.9 million residents of Puerto Rico who are also U S citizens and would raise the total to 45.2 million. This would make the U S population of Latinos the second largest Spanish origin population in the hemisphere after Mexico. The growth of this population since 1980 has been dramatic. Hispanics/Latinos grew more than seven times faster than the population of the nation as a whole, increasing by half, whereas the white non-Hispanic population increased by only 6% between 1980 and 1990. U S Bureau of the Census 1991 Table 1 U S Bureau of the Census 1993 p 2. In the 1990s the Hispanic population increased 58%. Moreover, between 2003 and 2004, one of every two people added to the nation's population was Hispanic/Latino. Consequently, not only are Latinos a substantial part of the U S population, but they account for half its population growth.

C. Alejandra Elenes develops her conceptualizations of border transformative pedagogies by linking the relationship between cultural practices, knowledge, and teaching in everyday life. Starving for Justice Ralph Armbruster-Sandoval, 2017-03-21 In the 1990s three college campuses in California exploded as Chicano a and Latino a students went on hunger strikes Through courageous self sacrifice these students risked their lives to challenge racial neoliberalism budget cuts and fee increases The strikers acted and spoke spectacularly and despite great odds produced substantive change Social movement scholars have raised the question of why some people risk their lives to create a better world In Starving for Justice Ralph Armbruster Sandoval uses interviews and archival material to examine people s willingness to make the extreme sacrifice and give their lives in order to create a more just society Popular memory and scholarly discourse around social movements have long acknowledged the actions of student groups during the 1960s Now Armbruster Sandoval extends our understanding of social justice and activism providing one of the first examinations of Chicana o and Latina o student activism in the 1990s Students at University of California Los Angeles University of California Santa Barbara and Stanford University went on hunger strikes to demand the establishment and expansion of Chicana o studies departments They also had even broader aspirations to obtain dignity and justice for all people These students spoke eloquently making their bodies and concerns visible They challenged anti immigrant politics They scrutinized the rapid growth of the prison industrial complex racial and class polarization and the university s neoliberalization Though they did not fully succeed in having all their demands met they helped generate long lasting social change on their respective campuses making those learning institutions more just

The Fight for Time Paul Apostolidis, 2019 In today s precarious world working people s experiences are strangely becoming more alike even as their disparities sharpen The Fight for Time explores the logic behind this paradox by listening to what Latino day laborers say about work and society The book shows how migrant laborers are both exception and synecdoche in relation to the precarious conditions of contemporary work life As unauthorized migrants these workers are subjected to extraordinarily harsh treatment yet in startling ways they also epitomize struggles that apply throughout the economy Juxtaposing day laborers descriptions of their desperate circumstances and dangerous work with theoretical accounts of the forces fueling insecurity The Fight for Time illuminates the temporal contradictions that define precarity today The book taps the core intellectual current among day labor groups Paulo Freire s popular education theory to craft an original critical popular approach for understanding the points of connection between the ways that day laborers view their lives and scholarly

Reform Without Justice Alfonso Gonzales, 2014 Placed within the context of the past decade's war on terror and emergent Latino migrant movement *Reform without Justice* addresses the issue of state violence against migrants in the United States It questions what forces are driving draconian migration control policies and why it is that despite its success in mobilizing millions the Latino migrant movement and its allies have not been able to more successfully defend the rights of migrants Gonzales argues that the contemporary Latino migrant movement and its allies face a dynamic form of political power that he terms anti migrant hegemony This type of political power is exerted in multiple sites of power from Congress to think tanks talk shows and local government institutions through which a rhetorically race neutral and common sense public policy discourse is deployed to criminalize migrants Most insidiously anti migrant hegemony allows for large sectors of pro immigrant groups to concede to coercive immigration enforcement measures such as a militarized border wall and the expansion of immigration policing in local communities in exchange for so called Comprehensive Immigration Reform Given this reality Gonzales sustains that most efforts to advance immigration reform will fail to provide justice for migrants This is because proposed reform measures ignore the neoliberal policies driving migration and reinforce the structures of state violence used against migrants to the detriment of democracy for all *Reform without Justice* concludes by discussing how Latino migrant activists especially youth and their allies can change this reality and help democratize the United States
