Gould, 1999 When it was acquired by the Center for American History at the University of Texas at Austin in 1986 the Natchez Trace Collection was one of the great unexplored treasures of southern history Its plantation records bank correspondence songbooks and family letters among many other gems combine to form a cornucopia of regional history Now seven noted southern historians act as guides through this still largely untapped resource Each examines one facet of the collection covering such topics as slavery women s roles the Old Southwest Jacksonian politics sectional conflict and the position of businessmen and entrepreneurs in the antebellum period

Global Perspectives on Industrial Transformation in the American South Michele Gillespie, 2005 Covering the late colonial age to World War I and beyond this collection of essays places the economic history of the American South in an international light by establishing useful comparisons with the larger Atlantic and world economy In an attempt to dispel long lasting myths about the South the essays analyze the economic evolution of the South since the slave era From this perspective the conception of a backward wholly agricultural antebellum South occupied only by wealthy planters poor whites and contented slaves has finally given way to one of economic and social dynamism as well as regional prosperity In a coherent and cohesive progression of subjects these essays show that the South had been deeply enmeshed in the Atlantic economy since the colonial period and after the Civil War retained distinctive needs that caused increasing departure from the course northerners adopted on matters of political economy This comparative approach also helps explain the motivations behind the political choices made by the South as an eminently export oriented region This book shows that the South was not slower to develop with respect to industrialization than either the majority of the northern states especially in the West or the countries of Western Europe In fact the apparently disappointing performance of the New South s economy appears to be the result of more pervasive and largely uncontrollable trends that affected the national as well as the international economy *Global Perspectives on Industrial Transformation in the American South* makes an important contribution to the economic history of the South and to recent efforts to place American history in a more international context

Jordan, 1996-01-01 In the war fevered spring and summer of 1861 a group of slaves in Adams County Mississippi conspired to gain their freedom by overthrowing and murdering their white masters The conspiracy was discovered the plotters were arrested and tried and at least forty slaves in and around Natchez were hanged By November the affair was over and the planters of the district united to conceal the event behind a veil of silence In 1971 Winthrop D Jordan came upon the central document previously unanalyzed by modern scholars upon which this extraordinary book is based a record of the testimony of some of the accused slaves as they were interrogated by a committee of planters determined to ferret out what was going on This discovery led him on a twenty year search for additional information about the aborted rebellion Because no official report or even newspaper account of the plot existed the search for evidence became a feat of historical detection Jordan gathered information from every possible source the private letters and diaries of members of the families involved in suppressing the conspiracy and of people who recorded the rumors that swept the Natchez area in the unsettled months following the beginning of the war letters from Confederate soldiers concerned about the events back home the journal of a Union officer who heard of the plot records of the postwar Southern Claims Commission census documents plantation papers even gravestones What has emerged from this odyssey of research is a brilliantly written re creation of one of the last slave conspiracies in the United States It is also a revealing portrait of the Natchez region at the very beginning of the Civil War when Adams County was one of the wealthiest communities in the nation and a few powerful families interconnected by marriage and business controlled not only a large black population but the poorer whites as well In piecing together the fragments of extant information about the conspiracy Jordan has produced a vivid picture of the plantation slave community in southwestern Mississippi in 1861 its composition
