of their surroundings They also never suffered a great and sudden collapse like other peoples of the ancient Near East such as the Hittites Assyrians and Neo Babylonians did A close examination of Sumerian culture and chronology reveals that the Sumerians set the cultural tone in Mesopotamia for several centuries in the realms of politics governments arts literature and religion The Sumerians were truly a great people whose legacy continued long after they were gone Even today the world owes the Sumerians a tremendous amount When Western Europe was still in the Stone Age it was the Sumerians who invented writing and the wheel divided time into minutes and seconds tamed nature and built gigantic cities They embraced culture and the arts and their caravans crossed the desert opening up the first trade routes.
