him to be a boy of unusual intelligence with a keen early interest in literature His doting mother ensured that her son had all the advantages of an upper middle class upbringing Her inheritance and donations from an aunt allowed the family to live a comfortable lifestyle In a rather unconventional style of parenting Fitzgerald attended Holy Angels with the peculiar arrangement that he go for only half a day and was allowed to choose which half *F.
