in leading universities including Merle Curti and Marcus Lee Hansen He circulated copies of his essays and lectures to important scholars and literary figures published extensively in highbrow magazines recycled favorite material attaining the largest possible audience for key concepts and wielded considerable influence within the American Historical Association as an officer and advisor for the American Historical Review His emphasis on the importance of the frontier in shaping American character influenced the interpretation found in thousands of scholarly histories By the time Turner died in 1932 60% of the leading history departments in the U S were teaching courses in frontier history along Turnerian lines Annoyed by the university regents who demanded less research and more teaching and state service Turner sought out an environment that would support research Declining offers from California he accepted a call to Harvard in 1910 and remained a professor there until 1922 being succeeded in 1924 by Arthur M Schlesinger Sr In 1907 Turner was elected a member of the American Antiquarian Society and in 1911 he was elected a fellow of the American Academy of Arts and Sciences Turner was never comfortable at Harvard when he retired in 1922 he became a visiting scholar at the Huntington Library in Los Angeles where his note cards and files continued to pile up although few monographs got published His *The Frontier in American History* 1920 was a collection of older essays
