

Kâma means desire. It is also the name of the motivating principle in the sevenfold human constitution.

Kâma-loka is literally the desire-world, which is a semi-material plane commonly called the astral world. There the shades of the departed remain for a certain length of time.

Kâma-rûpa—literally the desire-form; equivalent to the shade or eidolon. It is the subjective form created by means of the thoughts and desires of a person during life, which is projected as a form into the astral world after the death of the physical body.

Kanyâ—a girl, a virgin. Also the name of the zodiacal sign of Virgo.

Kapilavastu—the name of the birthplace of Gautama the Buddha.

Kârana—a word derived from the verb root *kri*, to do, to act; hence action, cause. Used metaphysically as the primal cause. In connection with the word *upâdhi*, compounded as:

Kâranopâdhi, it signifies the causal vehicle, in which reside the causal aspects of man's existence on earth. Equivalent to the buddhi-mânasîc aspect of man's constitution.

Karkataka—a crab; also the name of the zodiacal sign, Cancer.
