truly an alternative to political theology as Foucault has claimed and as Agamben does today As a first step the book addresses and clarifies various misunderstandings about the notion of political theology in its multiple and even opposite meanings It then focuses on a conceptualisation inaugurated by Carl Schmitt which sees political theology as the eloquent matrix of modern politics insofar as the latter produces and continuously re elaborates an excess that does not belong to it its core remains theological political although secularised. The state becomes the epistemologically necessary and normatively hopeful focal point only to the extent that it crystalises the identified agents historical struggles for self determination. The role of positivism is to protect the spaces of the actuality of reason that are the historical results of these struggles and from which new more transformative projects can arise Radical Democracy and
