Kafka's bilingualism is discussed in the context of contemporary essentialist views of a writer's organic language and identity. Nekula also pays particular attention to Kafka's education, examining his studies of Czech language and literature as well as its role in his intellectual life. The book concludes by asking how Kafka read his urban environment, looking at the readings of Prague encoded in his fictional and nonfictional texts. Nekula's work has had a major impact on our understanding of Kafka's relation to the complex social, cultural, and linguistic environment of early twentieth-century Prague. While little of this work has been available in English until now, the present volume translates many of his most important studies and includes revisions and expansions appearing now for the first time. Nekula challenges stubborn clichés and opens important new perspectives. Readers interested in questions relating to Kafka and Prague will find this an essential and richly rewarding book.
