events small and large in Francis s life including his troubled relations with his father his contacts with Clare of Assisi his encounter with the Muslim sultan and his receiving the Stigmata to uncover the man behind the legends and popular images A tour de force of historical research and biographical writing Francis of Assisi A New Biography is divided into two complementary parts a stand alone biographical narrative and a close annotated examination of the historical sources about Francis Taken together the narrative and the survey of the sources provide a much needed fresh perspective on this iconic figure As I have worked on this biography Thompson writes my respect for Francis and his vision has increased and I hope that this book will speak to modern people believers and unbelievers alike and that the Francis I have come to know will have something to say to them today
