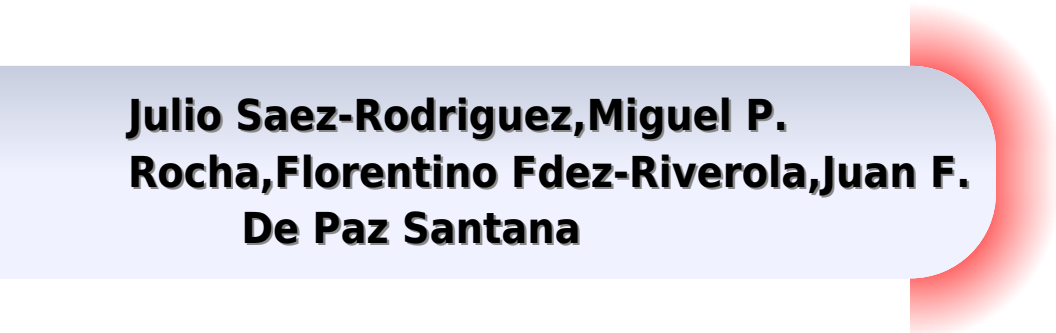

According to Moore's Law, which has held since the invention of the silicon chip, eighteen months is also the time frame in which computer power is expected to double. After surveying the core databases and other online resources, the focus shifts to tools and techniques for exploiting and authoring Internet distributed information.
