

'gives form a real independence of content such that it can appear to contradict its own determinants'. Since the object is contradictory, theory must capture this instead of trying to impose theoretically a consistency that does not exist. He ends by drawing attention to the importance of the money form for understanding value, and citing the innovative work by Duménil and by Foley, which is essentially a macro-economic interpretation, sidestepping the transformation problem altogether. 'New readers', in particular, will find this book a convenient way of catching up on the debate, while the high quality of many chapters, and the extensive bibliography, ensures its permanent value.

Of course, any editor faced with the problem of selection is not going to please everyone; however, in this case it is hard to quarrel with the way the brief has been met. It is especially pleasing that the Marx

paper has been rescued from obscurity. The topic is of such importance, and such intrinsic difficulty, that every scrap of evidence of Marx's thinking on the subject is valuable. As for important omissions: I indulge in a bit of lateral thinking here, to point out that the CSE published some books, now out of print. Important papers in themselves, which would also have suitably extended the range of positions represented here, are D. Elson's 'Value Theory of Labour' and J. Banaji's 'Hegel's Dialectic in Marx's *Capital*'; both were published in *Value: The Representation of Labour in Capitalism*, edited by Diane Elson in 1979. As several writers here remark, the state of theory is not independent of the state of the struggle in the real world. So the times may not be propitious for debates in value theory. But capitalism is not going to go away, and its crazy logic has still to be comprehended and attacked.

This is a collection in one volume of twelve of Wright's essays (apart from ch.4 which is composed jointly with Michael Burawoy) written between 1979 and 1993 and all but one – 'The Class Analysis of Poverty' (ch.2) – have previously seen publication on one or other side of the Atlantic either as chapters or articles.

Erik Olin Wright, a well-known member of the self-proclaimed, all male, NBSMG –

the Non-Bullshit Marxism Group – (otherwise known as 'Analytical Marxists'), interrogates inequality via an analysis of the class structure of capitalist societies and the desirable alternative to barbarism. By the way, for those who are interested to know 'What is Analytical Marxism?' Wright offers a comprehensive answer in ch.8, first published in the *Socialist Review*, no.4, 1989.
