Malamud Equally vocal and contentious Cold War women writers were unwilling to be silenced as Clark demonstrates in her discussion of the work of Mari Sandoz and Ursula Le Guin The book concludes with a discussion of how the silencing of gender race and class in Cold War writing maintained its discipline until the eruptions of the sixties By questioning the identity politics of manliness in the Cold War context of persecution and trial Clark finds that the involvement of men in identity politics set the stage for our subsequent cultural history Apocalyptic Transformation Elizabeth K.
