This original and innovative collection contributes to several different though obviously connected fields within the study of religion. It operates on five levels. In the first place the volume is the first to represent substantially the contribution of social science to the study of Quakerism and therefore provides useful comparative material for those whose focus is on other faith groups. Second the book focuses largely on British Quakerism and so enriches the pool of resources relating to the sociology of British religion and British culture more generally. Third there are very few sociological volumes dedicated to the analysis of a single faith group. Fourth the book represents an in depth study of a liberal faith group when liberal religion is the focus of much scholarly debate at present particularly with reference to the secularisation thesis.
