

menon) and Peircean semiotics (with its triadic emphasis) is not bridged, for example, though Levin's insightful paper does hold out the hope that such bridging is indeed ultimately possible. If one reads *The semiotic bridge* with a certain degree of detachment from any too strong expectations which its title might engender, there lies a delightfully broad-ranging and stimulating collection of ideas between its covers. One can conclude from such a reading that semiotics is alive and well in California and that it exhibits all the profuse diversity characteristic of that state.

Though Morris' was not the only contribution to it, the 1930's *International encyclopedia of unified science* never reached completion, and it may indeed be pointless to wish that it had. Rather, it seems more realistic and more fruitful to take delight in the many voices and many discourses which the human project of understanding the world in which we live seems to generate. Charles Sanders Peirce's ideal of a community of like-minded inquirers approaching truth together may find its fulfillment not in a monoligual community, but in a multilingual one. One's task, then, is to become a polyglot, and *The semiotic bridge* is a good place to start one's education, at least as far as semiotics is concerned.

With the exception of *Hedda Gabler*, Ibsen's later plays are not often performed, and they are no longer well known. Their ambiguities and complexities baffle and frustrate both interpreters and audiences. For all their surface realism, these plays are mood pieces whose emotional overtones outlast but do not resolve the plot contrivances.
