with a Real Jack in the Pulpit of the book s title After graduating from Wheaton College and the Boston School of Occupational Therapy Helen married John in 1937 beginning a shared life of serving small Episcopal parishes learning and teaching the arts of homesteading and laughing often In 1942 they bought Faith Homestead an old house with five acres in Duxbury Massachusetts Soon they had hens milk goats sheep ducks geese and pigs They began to garden in earnest attending conferences at the center for Biodynamic agriculture in Spring Valley New York to learn more Eventually they taught the principles of Biodynamics which honors the dynamic activity inherent in living plants and the agricultural arts to hundreds of visitors to Duxbury They learned that Biodynamic vegetables and fruits were carefully tended not with chemicals but with homegrown natural materials that helped the earth itself to retain and develop its fertility.
